In line with that announcement, there will be no optional in-person experiences associated with MGMT courses on campus until after 24<sup>th</sup> January. We will update and share with you any developments and changes as they occur. If the delivery format for a particular MGMT course changes, an email communication from the Faculty's Academic Programs Office will be sent to all students registered in the course, and the delivery mode for the course will be updated in the [SSC Course Schedule](#).

Please note, the Faculty of Management is only responsible for the delivery of MGMT courses. If you are taking a course offered by another Faculty, you'll need to verify the mode of delivery with that Faculty. Bear in mind the aforementioned communication from Santa Ono and Lesley Cormack to the entire UBC community earlier today re the majority of instruction across all faculties on both campuses of UBC being online until 24<sup>th</sup> January.
